- 1. Place Motherboard on workstation
- 2. <u>Install processor</u>

- 12. Power supply


PLACE MOTHERBOARD ON YOUR WORKSTATION



INSTALLING PROCESSOR

- 1. Flip Processor socket lever.
- 2. Grab the processor gently.
- 3. Line up the processor directional arrow with the arrow on the socket.
 - 4. Put processor in the socket.
 - 5. Close the socket via the lever
 - 6. Apply the thermal paste, if necessary.

INSTALL FAN



- Place the heat sink fan on top of the processor.
- 2. If necessary, snap the pins into the holes.


INSTALL RAM



- 1. If not already open, open the RAM tabs.
 - 2. Slide the RAM card into socket.

INSTALL PCI CARD(S)

- 1. Remove the top slot on the back of computer case
- 2. Remove plate and slide PCI card into place
 - 3. Press card into socket
 - 4. Screw bracket into place



MOUNT MOTHERBOARD

- 1. Take out the I/O shield
- 2. Line up the motherboard with the screw holes
 - 3. Grab the standoffs
 - 4. Screw them into the holes

INSTALL THE FRONT PANEL

- Grab cable labeled USB
- 2. Plug it into slot on motherboard called USB
 - 3. Grab cable labeled 1394
- 4. Plug it into slot on motherboard called 1394
 - 5. Grab cable labeled HD
- 6. Plug it into slot on motherboard called HD
 - 7. Grab cable labeled Audio
- 8. Plug it into slot on motherboard called Audio or Aud




Depending on Motherboard and case



INSTALL THE POWER BUTTON AND LED



- 2. Find the 8-pin header
- 3. Plug the cables into the 8-pin header (varies where it is on the motherboard)



INSTALL HARD DRIVE

- 1. Pull out hard drive tray
- 2. Put the HDD in the tray
- 3. Screw in the HDD on the tray
 - 4. Slide tray back in

OR

- 1. Slide bare HDD in
- 2. Screw it in to the HDD bay



Depending on the motherboard and case

INSTALL OPTICAL DRIVE

- 1. Pull out the plastic cover
- 2. Screw the drive into place



INSTALL SATA

- 1. Find the skinny black plug that protrudes from the power supply called, "The power cable."
 - 2. Plug it in the long pin on the HDD
 - 3. Find the red wire that came with the motherboard called, "the data cable."
 - 4. Plug it in the short pin on the HDD.
- 5. Plug the other end, if not already, into sockets on your motherboard labeled, "SATA."
 - 6. Repeat as many times as you have to.



MOUNT POWER SUPPLY



- 1. Find the power rectangle
- 2. Put the power supply fan toward the holes
 - 3. Screw screws into the power supply
